INTRODUCTION TO THE PROJECT





- building an understanding of the European Green Deal and the new business opportunities it offers.



We have held two online partners meeting in July and November and have enjoyed sharing ideas, exchanging insights, and creating a workplan that will see partners working together to develop the 3 main project outputs over the next 6 months. These are:

- AGILITe In-service training programme to build key digital competences of VET tutors using the EU's DigCompEdu Strategy.
- 2.AGILITe In-service training programme addressing the 5 competence areas in the 'Ideas & Opportunities' section of the EntreComp Framework to support the development of an entrepreneurial mindset within the VET community.
- 3. AGILITe In-service training programme for VET tutors that build an understanding of the principles of circularity and the European Green Deal.
