Developing the digital and entrepreneurial competencies of VET trainers to support agile entrepreneurship training



First of all, participants from 8 countries were happy to meet in Zagreb, Croatia to work on the AGILITe short-term joint staff training event.

As the project aims to assist in the development of digital and entrepreneurial competences of VET sector, 16 senior practitioners have been collaborating in the development and design of training curricula at the Calidus learning centre.

This transnational training event was focused on each of the 3 specific in-service elements addressed by the AGILITE consortium, namely: building the digital competence; strengthening entrepreneurial spirit; and building an understanding of the principles of circularity within the VET sector so tutors can raise awareness of the potential of the European Green Deal for business old and new through the circular economy.





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Our priority was to ensure that educators who integrate the AGILITe resources can do so from an informed perspective.

As well, we were happy to see each other during the face-to-face meeting in Sandefjord, Norway. At the meeting the partners, discussed the best way to complete the in-service training programme when the EduZines are available.

The In-service Training programmes of IO1, IO2 and IO3 comprise face-to-face and self-directed learning elements.

Under each IO, it was agreed that Face-to-Face elements will consist of:

- PPT presentation introducing the IO and training package. We will use the PPTs from the LTTA in Croatia and they will be updated to introduce the EduZines under each IO
- The relevant EduZines will complete the face-to-face aspects of the In-service training programme.


Following a brainstorm activities, it was agreed that each EduZine will be supported by two activities for the self-directed learnin (a Case Study and a problem-based learning activity).

So, the next steps are: to complete two activities for each of the EduZines; to train 8 VET professionals per partner as part of the In-service training programmes that we have created: to finish all the translations; to organise and host an AGILITe Multiplier Event with 25 external participants from the field of VET, Policy and Decision-Makers.
